Contingents requiring visa for entry into Spain, are required to furnish their personal details in the enclosed format to enable the organisers to send an official invitation letter for processing of the visa. The visa application form is available on the website: www.huelva2021.com so as to reach the organisers before the date specified in the form.

You must apply for your visa at least 30 working days before it is needed, to allow time for your application to be processed.

Please note, the letter of invitation the organisers provide does not guarantee granting of visa and / or entry into Spain and the final decision is made by the Spanish Embassy in your country or nearby Spanish consulates. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that they apply for their visa sufficiently in advance. Any issues with the visa application need to be dealt directly with the Embassy Official who is dealing with your application.

The organisers accept no responsibility nor are liable under any circumstances for the costs and / or difficulties because of non-granting of visa for any reason whatsoever.
