## MODALITIES ALLOWED AND ENTRY FEES

**Modalities allowed:** All players can register in up to five modalities

**Entry fees per player:** US\$100.00 for U11 to U17 and US\$60 for U19 who can only compete in three modalities.

Entry fees will be paid in cash before beginning of tournament. Otherwise, the players involved will not allowed to play. Sports organizations, clubs or academies entering a player/pair in the tournament will be responsible for payment of the registration fees.

## VISAS

All players and officials who require a visa to enter Peru should submit full their full name, passport number, date of Issue & expiry and contact number to [badminton@badmintonperu.com](mailto:badminton@badmintonperu.com) not later than October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, in order to provide them with an invitation letter for their visa application processes.

## MINORS TRAVELING WITHOUT THEIR PARENTS

Peruvian law requires that minors traveling without their parents present a notarized letter signed by their parents authorizing them to stay at the hotel of choice. Please check with the hotel you are booking to avoid difficulties upon arrival.

## UNIFORMS

The tournament will follow BPAC regulations for all tournaments that are part of the Pan American Circuit. **The player's name and the country name or code on the back of the shirt is mandatory.** (BWF GCR, referring player's clothing, designs, advertising and lettering)

## MEDICAL SERVICES

A doctor and a physiotherapist will be at the venue while matches are on.

## MEDICAL INSURANCE

To be arranged individually by participants.

## BADMINTON INTEGRITY

The tournament will follow section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matche(s).

## TRANSPORTATION

Uber also works well from Jorge Chavez airport, and services can be pre-arranged with vehicles of different sizes.
